

OPPOSITE PARTY

GIST OF THE CASE

Dayanidhi Khamari appeared on Dt. 26.02.2024 at camp held at SDO Office Belpahar and submitted a written complaint wherein she has stated about billing dispute & request to revise/rectify the same.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The opposite party has submitted bill abstract of the consumer from Nov-2019 to Sept-2023. No PVR or W/S has been submitted in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is pursued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-DOM consumer having CD 0.50KW with date of initial power supply 13.11.2018 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on billing dispute with prayer to revise the bill. Meanwhile, the meter SI No WM522955 was installed on 12.11.2018 with IMR '0' & MF 1 by replacing the old meter bearing SI No 8062718 & the meter SL No LW211432 was installed on 16.09.2022 with IMR '0' & MF 1. The above complainant has been served the bill with KWh reading of 5817 in Oct-2022 (22.11.2023) & also found LD from Aug-2023 and continued till date required to levy FC for the LD periods. During hearing it was decided in presence of both parties that on payment of Rs.15000.00 along with RC fees the power supply to be reconnect by opposite party and if required meter to be tested w.r.t regulation 108 for confirmation of the efficiency & record of meter reading thereon. Hence, revision is required to settle the billing dispute.

Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to revise the bill for the periods from 16.09.2022 to 22.11.2023 by spread over the reading of 5817 units with IMR '0' in reference to consumption recorded meter SI No LW211432 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof considering the adjustment of previous bill revisions as per law if any but after conducting physical verification & reporting thereon and if found any deviation to be taken care in accordance to law/regulation and if required meter to be tested w.r.t regulation 108 for confirmation of the efficiency & record of meter reading thereon. Hence, revision is required to settle the billing dispute.

ORDER

After careful consideration of hearing and data submitted by both parties the Forum is pleased to pass the Order as follows.

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill for the periods from 16.09.2022 to 22.11.2023 by spread over the reading of 5817 units with IMR '0' in reference to consumption recorded meter SI No LW211432 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof considering the adjustment of previous bill revisions as per law if any but after conducting physical verification & reporting thereon and if found any deviation to be taken care in accordance to law/regulation and if required meter to be tested w.r.t regulation 108 for confirmation of the efficiency & record of meter reading thereon. Hence, revision is required to settle the billing dispute.
- The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 3. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act, 2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
