GIST OF THE CASE

Sri Prashanta Ku Patel appeared on Dt. 18.07.2023 at the camp held on SDO Office Kuchinda and submitted a written complaint wherein he has stated about billing dispute & request to revise/rectify the same.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The opposite party has submitted billing abstract from April 2018 to Sept 2023 also a PVR carried on 18.07.2023 wherein it is found that Meter SI No is TPU35797 with remark given by concern authority that disputed bill may be rectify and also a hand written application from the consumer describing about his issues.

OBSERVATION

The case is persued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a Irrigation Pumping & Agriculture consumer having CD 2.25kw with date of initial power supply 20.05.2015 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on billing dispute with prayer to revise the bill & also expressed the displeasure. The meter Sl No TPU35797 was installed on 01.04.2022 with IMR as 0 & MF 1 where it is seen that the KWh reading on 28.11.2022 was 4486 but billing raised in in billing month Oct-2022 for billing units of 7451due to which arrear has been raised to Rs50309.13 from Rs.37769.10 which seems as improper & needs correction accordingly. Thereafter billing are going on accordingly with adjustment of bills as per applicability During course of hearing the complainant advised to avail OTSS-2022 & also agreed thereon but failed to do.

Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to revise the bill from 01.04.2022 to 28.11.2022 considering the considering the consumption recorded in meter SI No TPU35797 taking IMR as '0' on 01.04.2022 & FMR as 4486 on 28.11.2022 & the daily/monthly actual average consumption thereof.

ORDER

¹fter careful consideration of hearing and data submitted by both parties the Forum is pleased to pass the Order as follows.

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill from 01.04.2022 to 28.11.2022 considering the considering the consumption recorded in meter SI No TPU35797 taking IMR as '0' on 01.04.2022 & FMR as 4486 on 28.11.2022 & the daily/monthly actual average consumption thereof.
- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant
 has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for
 the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- 7. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
