GIST OF THE CASE

Sri Prasanta Kumar Sahu on behalf of Dharanidhar Sahu appeared in the hearing on Dt. 23.06.2025 at the camp held at SDO Office, Belpahar. The Complainant filed the petition objected to abnormal energy bill charged against his domestic connection. The complainant could not emphatically submit the period and nature of billing dispute. Hence, the Complainant prayed before the Forum to direct the Opposite Party to resolve the billing disputes in an efficacious manner.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The opposite party has submitted billing abstract from Nov-2012 to May-2025, copy of Physical Verification Report dtd.30.06.2025 and the copy of photo reading of meter No" LW056174".

OBSERVATION

The case is pursued with all documents available on record and merit of the case. The complainant is an existing consumer of electricity under the operational area of TPWODL bearing consumer No 4172-1208-0180, having CD-0.15KW under LT-Domestic category, coming under ESO-Belpahar & initial power supply effected on 01.08.2012. On scrutinizing the records in detail, the Forum observed the following facts which are envisaged here under that,

- 1. That, on examining the case in detail, the Forum observed from the billing records Hat March-2025 bill was charged on actual basis, wrongly considering the CMD of "2891.00" KVA, in the meter No" LW056174", that led to abnormal charging of Monthly Minimum Fixed Charge (MMFC) of Rs. 57820.00/- for the month, out of the total arrear outstanding of Rs. 67731.31/- upto May-2025 billing.
- 2. The ledger abstract revealed that CMD for January-25, February-25 and April-2025 were recorded as "0.15000" KVA in each month, except in March-2025, wherein the CMD of "2891.00" KVA was recorded for billing.

3. The past records indicated that nowhere in billing history such abnormal Maximum Demand (M.D.) was recorded previously. Further, such abnormal M.D. is not symmetrical with the contracted load (C.D.) of only "0.15"KW.

On verifying the records, reports available on record and the petition filed by the complainant, the Forum construed that the abnormal MMFC so charged particularly in March-2025 was found to be incorrect & illegitimately charged. Hence, the Opposite Party is required to revise the Monthly Minimum Fixed Charge (MMFC) only so raised in March-2025, considering the CMD of "0.15000" KVA, to redress the grievances accordingly.

ORDER

After careful consideration of hearing and documents, statements available on records, the Forum hereby passes order in consonance with Regulation of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply), Code, 2019

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the Monthly Minimum Fixed Charge(MMFC) only so charged in March-2025 billing, considering the CMD of "0.15000" KVA for the month.
- 2. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the issue of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking into account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant
- 3. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived at, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to which the complainant is liable to pay.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.

The Opposite Party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of the issue of this order.
