GIST OF THE CASE

Sri Jogendra Meher is the complainant who appeared on Dt. 13.10.2023 at camp held on ESO Office -3 under SDO-I Jharsuguda and submitted a written complaint wherein he has stated that "High billing in the month of Dec-2021. So, he requests to revise the bill as per actual meter reading of new meter."

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The Opposite Party has not submitted any relevant documents in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is persued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-GP consumer having CD 1.55HP with date of initial power supply 01.01.1990 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on high billing dispute with prayer to revise the bill. The above complainant has already been served actual bills up to April-2022 with KWH reading of 32716 (Dt.13.05.2022) in reference consumption recorded in meter Sl No 8029137. PL bills were served from 14.05.2023 to 27.07.2023. The meter Sl No WLT063161 was installed on 28.07.2022 with IMR '0' & MF 1.The opposite party has already been revised the bill for delay meter updating & defective period assessment has also done for the period from July-2022 to Aug 2023 (28.07.2022 to 04.09.2023) & withdrawn an amount of Rs.17774.93 & Rs.32390.70 for the period May-2022 to June 2022 respectively. Hence, required revision to settle the billing dispute.

Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to revise the bill for the periods from Jan-2011 to Feb-2022 by spread over the reading of 32716 with IMR '0' in reference to consumption recorded meter SI No 8029137 & for the period from 14.05.2023 to 27.07.2023 taking IMR as '0' on 28.07.2022 & FMR as '256' on 02.09.2023 with reference to consumption recorded meter SI No WLT063161 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof considering the adjustment of previous bill revisions as per law.

ORDER

After careful consideration of hearing and data submitted by both parties the Forum is pleased to pass the Srder as follows.

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill for the periods from Jan-2011 to Feb-2022 by spread over the reading of 32716 with IMR '0' in reference to consumption recorded meter SI No 8029137 & for the period from 14.05.2023 to 27.07.2023 taking IMR as '0' on 28.07.2022 & FMR as '256' on 02.09.2023 with reference to consumption recorded meter SI No WLT063161 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof considering the adjustment of previous bill revisions as per law.
- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 3. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.

7. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.
