OPPOSITE PARTY

GIST OF THE CASE

The Complainant has filed the petition in the name of Basudev Pradhan bearing Consumer No **4140-0106-0274** represented by Laxman Pradhan under DED, TPWODL, Deogarh stated about revise the bill by changing the category from GP to LI as supply is being for Irrigation purpose. Presently supply is under disconnection, so requested to reconnect the supply as they are farmers need of supply for irrigation.

Hence, the Complainant prayed before the Forum to consider the case for revision/rectification.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The Opposite Party has not submitted any relevant documents except ledger copy for the period from Oct'2022 to Aug'2023 in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is pursued with all documents available in records (FG data base and Samadhan App) and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-GP consumer having CD 15kwwith initial date of p/s 19.10.2022 through meter sl. no."10006851" as seen from the FG data base/ Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection as mentioned in the gist of the case. This Forum has issued an interim order on the camp date 13.09.2024 to reconnect the p/s taking Rs 10,000/- towards dues of electricity and to take up the categories change as well as revision of bill. The opposite party could not file the PVR and w/s but during discussion in later stage over phone confirmed that the bill has been raised on GP tariff with reference to regulation 138(e). However, the opposite party has forgotten to pay attention on the decision taken by TPWODL authorities on 27.07.2022 where it clearly stated that a single consumer no. having multiple beneficiaries for use of irrigation purpose (Cultivation) to be treated as LI category for each beneficiary. In this case, the opposite is supposed to treat the above complainant as LI category since date of its p/s and onward periods for used of irrigation and revision is required to settle the grievance after due verification thereon by opposite party.

Hence, the Forum is in the opinion that the Opposite party is liable to convert the tariff from GP to IPA(Irrigation Pumping and Agriculture) since date of its initial p/s to till date and onward periods also upto the use of irrigation purpose only after due verification thereon by opposite party and revise the bill for the period from the date of P/s to till date basing on the consumption recorded in meter sl. no." 10006851" as well as withdraw the DPS as levied on serving wrong bills to the complainant and also the complainant should pay the dues if arrived after bill revision for getting the opportunity of reconnection of p/s.

ORDER

Considering the documents and statements submitted by both the parties at the time of hearing, the Forum hereby passes orders that:

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to convert the tariff from GP to IPA(Irrigation Pumping and Agriculture) since date of its initial p/s to till date and onward periods also upto the use of irrigation purpose only after due verification thereon by opposite party and revise the bill for the period from the date of P/s to till date basing on the consumption recorded in meter sl. no." 10006851" as well as withdraw the DPS as levied on serving wrong bills to the complainant.
- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier and adjust the revision as per law/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection/getting opportunity of reconnection of p/s.
- Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
