OPPOSITE PARTY

GIST OF THE CASE

The Complainant has filed the petition in the name of Krushan Ch. Bag bearing Consumer No 4118-3312-0106 represented by Sulochana Bag under SED, TPWODL, Sambalpur stated that deposited Rs 20,000/- towards EC bill with the request to revise the bill and also declared that Rs 15,000/- has already been withdrawn but prayed to check the meter and serve the bill accordingly. On 19.09.2024 the complainant has also deposited of Rs 16,000/- as well as the meter testing fees.

Hence, the Complainant prayed before the Forum to consider the case for meter testing and correction of bill as per law.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The Opposite Party has not submitted any relevant documents in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is pursued with all documents available in records (FG data base and Samadhan App) and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-domestic consumer having CD 1kw with initial date of p/s 07.08.2009 as seen from the FG data base/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on efficiency of meter and billing thereon. As seen, the complainant has paid of Rs 20,000/- and 16,000/- on 19.07.2024 and 19.09.2024 respectively. The opposite party has revised the bill and withdrawn an amount of Rs 15,201.73/- which was credited in ledger on 07.08.2024 and debited Rs 2,903.40/- towards meter change assessment in Aug'2022 as seen from the Samadhan App. But, the complainant is not satisfied on the bill revision so done by opposite party and doubt on the efficiency on functioning of the meter. The complainant has declared that the meter testing fees was deposited on 19.09.2024 which to be verified by opposite party.

Hence, the Forum is in the opinion that the Opposite party is liable to test the meter after confirmation of the deposit of the meter testing fees or otherwise debit the meter testing fees in the consumer no. if found unpaid and accordingly revise the bill further if found any discrepancy in the meter testing report with adjustment of previous bill revision and amount involved thereon as per accounting principle and law applicable for the purpose.

ORDER

Considering the documents and statements submitted by both the parties at the time of hearing, the Forum hereby passes orders that:

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to test the meter after confirmation of the deposit of the meter testing fees or otherwise debit the meter testing fees in the consumer no. if found unpaid and accordingly revise the bill further if found any discrepancy in the meter testing report with adjustment of previous bill revision and amount involved thereon as per accounting principle and law applicable for the purpose.
- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier and adjust the revision as per law/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 3. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- 7. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.
 Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
