## GIST OF THE CASE

Sri Pintu Sarkar appeared before this Forum on behalf of the consumer Late S D Sarkar is a domestic consumer bearing No 4172-1202-0288 with CD 3KW and its date of power supply is 01.01. 1990 submitted a written complain wherein he states about billing dispute & request to revise the same.

# SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The opposite party has submitted bill abstract of the consumer from Aug-2013 to Dec-2023 & a PVR carried on 24.01.2024 received on 16.02.2024 by courier wherein it is found that meter SI No LW644863 with CMR7211KWh with meter status OK & also submitted a W/S in this case.

## **OBSERVATION**

The case is persued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-DOM consumer having CD 3KW with date of initial power supply 01.01.1990 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on billing dispute with prayer to revise the bill. Meanwhile, the meter Sl No LW644863 was installed on 26.04.2023 with IMR '0'. The opposite party has raised actual bill in June-2021 for KWh reading of 5916 in reference to consumption recorded in meter Sl No WCV38748. From July-2021 to March-2023 PL bills were served to the complainant & in April-2023 billed for 4265 units with KWh reading of 4229 has happened due to improper meter reading time to time & the supressed reading has been billed in that month hence developed much bill in that month. Might be the meter has been changed since July-2021 but recorded in data base on 26.04.2023. The opposite party has submitted the meter change on 25.05.2022 without any document evidence in its proof hence not acceptable & benefit of doubt will pass to the hands of the complainant. Hence, required revision to settle the billing dispute.

Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to revise the bill for the periods from 18.07.2021 to 18.05.2023 by spread over the reading of 4229 units with IMR '0' in reference to consumption recorded meter Sl No LW644863 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof considering the adjustment of previous bill revisions as per law if any.

#### **ORDER**

Ler careful consideration of hearing and data submitted by both parties the Forum is pleased to pass the Order as follows.

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill for the periods from 18.07.2021 to 18.05.2023 by spread over the reading of 4229 units with IMR '0' in reference to consumption recorded meter S1 No LW644863 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof considering the adjustment of previous bill revisions as per law if any.
- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 3. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- 7. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.
