OPPOSITE PARTY

GIST OF THE CASE

Sri Kamal Kanti Pradhan on behalf of Kalandi Charan Pradhan appeared in the hearing on Dt. 12.02.2025 at the camp held at SDO Office, Hirakud and submitted a written complaint wherein he has raised objection about wrong updation if meter change report in billing data base, which has resulted in wrong charging of additional bill amount. The complainant asserted that the meter No "LW569153" was actually installed in the premises in march-2020 but was wrongly updated in database as 28.08.2022. Hence, the complainant prayed before the Forum to direct the Opposite Party to correct the metering attributes into billing fold and revise the abnormal additional bills charged for necessary redressal of his grievances.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The Opposite Party could not submit any relevant document in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is perused with all documents available on record and merit of the case. The complainant is an existing consumer of electricity under the operational area of TPWODL bearing consumer No 4118-3206-0127, having CD-1.54KW under LT-Domestic category, coming under ESO-Hirakud & initial power supply effected on 01.01.1990. On scrutinizing the records in detail, the Forum observed the following facts which are envisaged here under that,

- 1. That, from Feb-2020 to March-2022, provisional bills were charged and from April-2022 to Nov-2022, average bills were raised.
- 2. It was observed from FG data base (Licensee soft records) that a new meter Sl No-"LW569153" was installed in the premises on 28.08.2022, reflected in billing during Sept-2022. But, average bills continued to charged from Sept-2022 till Nov-2022.
- 3. Thereafter, actual bills continued to charge from Dec-2022 onwards.
- The ledger abstract revealed that Rs.45,847.55/- was debited/added to consumer's Account on 27.12.2022 for revision of earlier bills from Aug-2022 to Nov-2022 (i.e. from the date of installation of above meter to Nov-2022) due to delay meter updation & on comparison of the average billing units with the new meter average consumption after installation of the same.
- 5. That, the complainant objected about wrong updation of (meter Sl No-"LW569153") actual installation date of the existing meter. The Opposite Party was asked to submit the same meter installation protocol as updated in billing data base on 28.08.2022, to ascertain the exact date of installation. However, the Opposite Party failed to submit the same after giving sufficient reasonable time to furnish. President

6. It was revealed from records that the meter Sl No-"LW569153" was installed on 28.08.2022 and advanced reading as on Dec-2022 billing was recorded as "8044" KWh within a span of four month or so. Hence, it was inferred that the same meter might have been installed much before the updated date as 28.08.2022, especially considering the consumer category and load as Domestic and CD-1.54KW respectively. The Opposite Party failed to submit the exact date of installation of meter Sl No-"LW569153" and hence, the Forum could not ascertain date of installation of above mete.

Therefore, the Forum construed that the bill revision carried out by the Opposite Party, considering the revision period from Aug-2022 to Nov-2022, thereby debiting Rs.45847.55/- effected in billing on 27.12.2022, is not justified and not genuinely charged. Hence, the Forum is of the considered opinion that the average billing raised from Jan-2021 to Dec-2022 are to be revised based on the six monthly actual average consumption recorded in meter Sl No-"LW569153", to be derived by considering the period from Jan-2023 to June-2023.

ORDER

After careful consideration of hearing and documents, statements available on records, the Forum hereby passes order in consonance with Regulation of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply), Code,2019

1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the energy bills charged from Jan-2021 to Dec-2022 on the basis of actual monthly average consumption as recorded in meter Sl No-"LW569153" to be evaluated considering IMR as '8044' KWh and FMR as '9209' thereby, all adjusting the bill revision made earlier and/or, the benefit arising out of the OTS Scheme, if any.

The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the issue of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking into account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant

3. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived at, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to which the complainant is liable to pay.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.

The Opposite Party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of the issue of this order
