GIST OF THE CASE

Dileswari Dhibar on behalf of Hadi Penthei has appeared in the hearing on Dt. 21.11.2024 at the camp held at ESO Office, Barkote and submitted a written complaint wherein she has stated about billing dispute- High Billing due to defective meter & request to revise/rectify the same.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The opposite party has not submitted any relevant documents except billing abstract from Sept 2020 to Aug 2024 in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is pursued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-DOM consumer having CD of 0.25KW with date of initial power supply on Dt.10.09.2019 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on billing dispute as mentioned in GIST with prayer to revise the bill. The complainant has been served actual bill for 1306 unit with KWh reading of 1478 in July 2022 w.r.t consumption recorded in meter SI No 3020162. Since Aug 2022 to Feb 2024 PL/Avg bills were served to the complainant. Meanwhile, the meter with SI No TWB114982 was in billing in March 2024 & giving advance reading as per recorded consumption.

Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to spread over the reading of 1478 KWh with IMR 0 for the periods from 10.09.2019 to July 2022 with reference to consumption recorded in meter SI No 3020162 & revise the bill for the period from Aug 202 to Feb 204 with reference to consumption recorded in meter SI No TWB114982 taking IMR as 23 in April 2024 & FMR as 61 in Sept 2024 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof, considering the adjustment of previous bill revisions if any as per law & also withdraw the proportionate DPS from billing.

ORDER

fter careful consideration of hearing and data submitted by both parties the Forum is pleased to pass the Order as follows.

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to spread over the reading of 1478 KWh with IMR 0 for the periods from 10.09.2019 to July 2022 with reference to consumption recorded in meter Sl No 3020162 & revise the bill for the period from Aug 2022 to Feb 2024 with reference to consumption recorded in meter SI No TWB114982 taking IMR as 23 in April 2024 & FMR as 61 in Sept 2024 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof, considering the adjustment of previous bill revisions if any as per law & also withdraw the proportionate DPS from billing.
- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period revised earlier and adjust the revision as per law/for the period of penalty/in both cases, if any, as applicable as it has not submitted any information for the same.
- The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the benefits of OTS scheme and rebate thereof, if any, as applicable as it has not submitted any information for the same.
- The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking into account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, serve the 5. Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived at, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
