#### **GIST OF THE CASE**

Madam Mohan Dhal has appeared in the hearing on Dt. 19.12.2024 at the camp held at Division Office, DED, Deogarh & submitted a written complaint wherein he has stated about billing dispute & has requested to revise/rectify the bill.

### SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The opposite party has submitted billing abstract from Aug-2014 to Nov-2024 & in this case.

### **OBSERVATION**

The case is pursued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-IPA consumer having CD of 3KW with date of initial power supply on Dt.23.08.2017 without meter up to jan-2020 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on billing dispute as mentioned in GIST with prayer to revise the bill. PL/Avg bills were served from Feb-2020 to Jan-2022 although meter SL No WLT166646 which was showing in billing data base. The meter Sl No TPU29884 was in billing in Feb-2022. The opposite party has provided the p/s violating the Regulation 97(ii) & also not billed on actual basis although showing the meter in the data base & for that the complainant has no fault. So, bill revision is required to settle the billing dispute.

Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to revise the bill from date of power supply to Jan-2022 by taking IMR as 967 in Dec-2023 & FMR as 1543 in May-2024 considering the matter in a lenient view being the complainant is cultivator with reference to consumption recorded in meter SI No TPU29884 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof with the adjustment of previous bill revisions if any as per law.

## **ORDER**

After careful consideration of hearing and data submitted by both parties the Forum is pleased to pass the Order as follows.

1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill from date of power supply to Jan-2022 by taking IMR as 967 in Dec-2023 & FMR as 1543 in May-2024 considering the matter in a lenient view being the complainant is cultivator with reference to consumption recorded in meter SI No TPU29884 with the daily/monthly actual consumption thereof with the adjustment of previous bill revisions if any as per law.



- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period revised earlier and adjust the revision as per law/for the period of penalty/in both cases, if any, as applicable as it has not submitted any information for the same.
- 3. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the benefits of OTS scheme and rebate thereof, if any, as applicable as it has not submitted any information for the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking into account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, serve the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived at, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- 7. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
