ORDER

Brief Facts of the Case

During the spot hearing at Chhend section of Rourkela Sadar Electrical Division camp on 20-02-2024, the complainant appeared before the Forum whereas SDO-I, RSED appeared as respondent before the Forum.

Brief facts pertaining to the case are that the Complainant is a LT-General Purpose consumer having consumer No. 814122150191 with connected load of 3.00 KW. That the Complainant has raised objection the wrong bill served to him during the disconnection period. He requested for revision of bills and mentions about verbal complaint being made to the respondent earlier on.

Gist of Arguments made by the Parties

Both parties were present in the hearing. The contentions made by the parties are as follows:

1. Submission of the Complainant:

- The complainant submits that, average bills have been served to him during the disconnection period due to which high billings have been done resulted to accumulation of arrear.
- He further submits that; he had made verbal complain to the respondent about the erroneous bill.
- He also requested the Forum to revise the bills.

2. Reply Submission of the Respondent:

- The respondent produced the billing abstract from Aug'2021 to Jan'2023 and a PVR dated 18-12-2023 mentioning the supply is disconnected from 09-03-2022.
- The respondent also agreed to the provisional/average billing from Mar'2022 to Jan'2023 and agreed for revision of bills. However, the respondent requested the Forum to take appropriate decision as necessary.

Findings of the Forum

Written/verbal Submissions were made by both parties and arguments were heard at length. This Forum, after hearing the parties and going through the relevant documents and provisions of law have concluded as follows:

- That the complainant has been billed on actual meter readings up to Aug'2021 with a meter reading of "14844" of meter no. WESCO9044758. From Sep'2021 to Jan'2023, provisional/average bills have been served.
- As per PVR submitted by the respondent, the supply was disconnected from 09-03-2022 as per request by the complainant. The complainant had also deposited the disconnection fees vide MR No. B6/4144074 dated 09-03-2022.
- Therefore, it is decided by the Forum that, the average period bills should be Withdrawn.


Directions of the forum

In view of the above findings and discussions, the Forum is of the view that,

- As the complainant has not availed the power supply, the bills from Mar'2022 to Jan'2023 are to be withdrawn. Only fixed charges are to be claimed.
- Any adjustments done during the revision period are also to be taken in to consideration.
- DPS charged on the wrong bills are also to be withdrawn.

Matter is closed herewith and the compliance report to be submitted to the undersigned on or before dated **31-03-2024**.

"If the complainant is aggrieved with this order or non-implementation of the order of the Grievance Redressal Forum in time, he/she can make the representation to the Ombudsman-II, Qrs. No. 3R-2(S), GRIDCO Colony, P.O: Bhoinagar, Bhubaneswar-751022 within 30 days from the date of order of the Grievances Redressal Forums".
