ORDER

Brief Facts of the Case

During the spot hearing at Rajgangpur-I Electrical Sub-division of Rajgangpur Electrical Division camp on 23-02-2024, the complainant appeared before the Forum whereas SDO- Rajgangpur-I appeared as respondent before the Forum.

Brief facts pertaining to the case are that the Complainant is a LT- Domestic consumer having consumer No. 813111060702 with connected load of 1.00 KW. That the Complainant has raised objection the wrong bill served to him during the no power supply period. He requested for revision of bills and mentions about verbal complaint being made to the respondent earlier on.

Gist of Arguments made by the Parties

Both parties were present in the hearing. The contentions made by the parties are as follows:

1. Submission of the Complainant:

- The complainant submits that, average bills have been served to him during the no power supply period due to which high billings have been done resulted to accumulation of arrear.
- He further submits that; he had made verbal complain to the respondent about the erroneous bill.
- He also requested the Forum to revise the bills.

2. Reply Submission of the Respondent:

- The respondent produced the billing abstract from Nov'2020 to Dec'2023 and a PVR dated 22-01-2024 mentioning the meter reading as "114" KWH of meter no. TPWODL1154942.
- The respondent also agreed to the provisional/average billing from Nov'2020 to Jan'2023 during no power supply period and agreed for revision of bills. However, the respondent requested the Forum to take appropriate decision as necessary.

Findings of the Forum

Written/verbal Submissions were made by both parties and arguments were heard at length. This Forum, after hearing the parties and going through the relevant documents and provisions of law have concluded as follows:

- That, as per billing data the complainant has been given power supply on 16-07-2020 without a meter and billing started from Nov'2020. From Nov'2020 to Jan'2023, provisional/average bills have been served @ of 657 units, 262 units, 144 units etc. due to without meter. From Feb'2023 to Jul'2023 no bills have been generated.
- As per PVR submitted by the respondent, the consumer was registered under the Soubhagya scheme but no power supply was provided at that time. The actual date of power supply is 22-08-2023 with installation of a new meter bearing Sl. No. TPWODL1154942.
- Therefore, it is decided by the Forum that, the average period bills should be withdrawn.

Directions of the forum

In view of the above findings and discussions, the Forum is of the view that,

- As the complainant has not availed the power supply, the bills from Feb'2021 to Jan'2023 (Two Years) are to be withdrawn.
- Any adjustments done during the revision period are also to be taken in to consideration.
- DPS charged on the wrong bills are also to be withdrawn.

Matter is closed herewith and the compliance report to be submitted to the undersigned on or before dated **31-03-2024**.

"If the complainant is aggrieved with this order or non-implementation of the order of the Grievance Redressal Forum in time, he/she can make the representation to the Ombudsman-II, Qrs.
