## **ORDER**

### **Brief Facts of the Case**

During the spot hearing at Rajgangpur-I Electrical Sub-division of Rajgangpur Electrical Division camp on 20-04-2024, the complainant appeared before the Forum whereas SDO- Rajgangpur-I appeared as respondent before the Forum.

Brief facts pertaining to the case are that the Complainant is a LT-Domestic consumer having consumer No. 813115120027 with connected load of 3.00 KW. That the Complainant has raised objection regarding the provisional/average bills served to him. He requested for revision of bills and mentions about verbal complaint being made to the respondent earlier on.

#### Gist of Arguments made by the Parties

Both parties were present in the hearing. The contentions made by the parties are as follows:

## 1. Submission of the Complainant:

- The complainant submits that, high consumption bills have been served to him resulted to accumulation of arrear.
- He further submits that; he had made verbal complain to the respondent about the erroneous bill.
- He also requested the Forum to revise the bills.

#### 2. Reply Submission of the Respondent:

- The respondent produced the billing abstract from Aug'2021 to Feb'2024 and a PVR dated 27-03-2024 mentioning the meter reading as "737" KWH of meter no. 300072244.
- The respondent also agreed to the provisional/average billing from Sep'2022 to May'2023 and agreed for revision of bills. However, the respondent requested the Forum to take appropriate decision as necessary.

#### Findings of the Forum

Written/verbal Submissions were made by both parties and arguments were heard at length. This Forum, after hearing the parties and going through the relevant documents and provisions of law have concluded as follows:

That the complainant has been billed on actual meter readings up to Aug'2022 with a meter reading of "1475" of meter no. LW123067. From Sep'2022 to May'2023, provisional/average bills have been served @ of 461 units, 504 units, 446 units etc. due to meter defective.

• In the meanwhile, a new meter bearing Sl. No. 300072244 has been installed on 18-07-2023 in the premises of the complainant.

• Therefore, it is decided by the Forum that, average period bills should be revised.

• It is also noted that, after meter change the billing for the month of Jun'2023 has been done @198 units taking the higher average units of previous billing despite the meter reading of the new meter has been recorded as "11", which also needs revision.

## **Directions of the forum**

In view of the above findings and discussions, the Forum is of the view that,

 The provisional/average bills served to the complainant from Sep'2022 to Jun'2023 are to be revised as per the average of six consecutive billing of new meter as per Section 155 and 157 of Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code, 2019.

 Any adjustments done during the revision period are also to be taken in to consideration.

• DPS charged on the wrong bills are also to be withdrawn.

Matter is closed herewith and the compliance report to be submitted to the undersigned on or before dated **31-05-2024**.

"If the complainant is aggrieved with this order or non-implementation of the order of the Grievance Redressal Forum in time, he/she can make the representation to the Ombudsman-II, Qrs. No. 3R-2(S), GRIDCO Colony, P.O: Bhoinagar, Bhubaneswar-751022 within 30 days from the date of order of the Grievances Redressal Forums".
