# **ORDER**

## **Brief Facts of the Case**

During the spot hearing at Bonai Electrical Section of Rourkela Sadar Electrical Division camp on 26-06-2024, the complainant appeared before the Forum whereas SDO-Bonai, RSED appeared as respondent before the Forum.

Brief facts pertaining to the case are that the Complainant is a LT-Domestic consumer having consumer No. 814712190876 with connected load of 0.50 KW. That the Complainant has raised objection regarding the provisional and average bills served to him. He requested for revision of bills and mentions about verbal complaint being made to the respondent earlier on.

## **Gist of Arguments made by the Parties**

Both parties were present in the hearing. The contentions made by the parties are as follows:

### **1. Submission of the Complainant:**

- The complainant submits that, average bills have been served to him due to which high billings have been done resulted to accumulation of arrear.
- He further submits that; he had made verbal complain to the respondent about the erroneous bill.
- He also requested the Forum to revise the bills.

### **2. Reply Submission of the Respondent:**

- The respondent produced the billing abstract from Sep'2018 to May'2024 and a PVR dated 20-06-2024 mentioning the meter reading as "28" of meter no. TWNX502444.
- The respondent also agreed to the provisional/average billing from May'2022 to Oct2023 and agreed for revision of bills. However, the respondent requested the Forum to take appropriate decision as necessary.

## **Findings of the Forum**

Written/verbal Submissions were made by both parties and arguments were heard at length. This Forum, after hearing the parties and going through the relevant documents and provisions of law have concluded as follows:

- That the complainant has been billed on actual meter readings up to Apr'2022 with a meter reading of "1793" of meter no. LW044971. From May'2022 to Oct2023, provisional/average bills have been served @ of 606 units, 1669 units, 361 units etc. due to defective meter.
- In the meanwhile, a new meter bearing SI. No. TWNX502444 has been installed on 20-11-2023 in the premises of the complainant.
- Therefore, it is decided by the Forum that, the average period bills should be revised.

### **Directions of the forum**

In view of the above findings and discussions, the Forum is of the view that,

- The provisional/average bills served to the complainant from May'2022 to Oct2023 are to be revised as per the average of six consecutive billing of new meter as per Section 155 and 157 of Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code, 2019.
- Any adjustments done during the revision period are also to be taken in to consideration.
- DPS charged on the wrong bills are also to be withdrawn.

Matter is closed herewith and the compliance report to be submitted to the undersigned on or before dated **31-07-2024**.

*"If the complainant is aggrieved with this order or non-implementation of the order of the Grievance Redressal Forum in time, he/she can make the representation to the Ombudsman-II, Qrs.
