### ORDER

### **Brief Facts of the Case**

During the spot hearing at Sundargarh, Electrical Sub-division, Sundargarh camp on dt.19.02.2025, the complainant appeared before the Forum whereas SDO, SED, Sundargarh appeared as respondent before the Forum.

Brief facts pertaining to the case are that the Complainant is an LT-Dom Consumer no- 8121-2117-0284 having connected load of 3.00 KW. That the Complainant has raised objection for provisional/average billing from Mar'2024 to Jul'2024. He requested revision of bills and mentions about verbal complaints being made to the respondent earlier on.

# Gist of Arguments made by the Parties

Both parties were present in the hearing. The contentions made by the parties are as follows:

## Submission of the Complainant:

- The complainant submitted that provisional/average bills have been generated from Mar'2024 to Jul'2024 to which high billings have been done resulted to accumulation of arrears.
- He further submitted that he had made verbal complaint to the respondent about the erroneous bill.
- He also requested the Forum to revise the bills.

# Reply Submission of the Respondent:

- The respondent produced the following documents:
  - Billing abstract from Jan'2024 to Jan'2025.
  - Physical Verification Report on dt.13.02.2025.
  - Written version on dt. 19.02.2025.
- The respondent also agreed to the wrong billing from Mar'2024 to Jul'2024 and revision of bills.
- However, the respondent requested the Forum to take appropriate decisions as necessary.

#### Findings of the Forum

Written/verbal Submissions were made by both parties and arguments were heard at length. This Forum, after hearing the parties and going through the relevant documents and provisions of law have concluded as follows:

- From Mar'2024 to Jun'2024 average bills have been served with various units per month as the meter is defective.
- A new meter bearing SI. No. TWSP51139274 had been installed on dt. 09.08.2024 and the current reading is "101" Kwh as on dt. 13.02.2025.
- Bill served during Jul'2024 is on pro-rata basis needs revision.
- Therefore, it is decided by the Forum to revise the average bills.

### **Directions of the forum**

In view of the above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations 155 and 157 of the Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code, 2019.

- The provisional/average bills served from Mar'2024 to Jul'2024 are to be revised by taking average of six consecutive billing of new meter.
- Any adjustments made during the revision period are also to be taken into consideration.
- DPS charged on the wrong bills are also to be withdrawn.
- The complainant must clear all the dues upon revision of bills.

The matter is closed herewith.
