ORDER

Brief Facts of the Case

During the spot hearing at Sundargarh Electrical Section of Sundargarh Electrical Division camp on dt.14.08.2024, the complainant appeared before the Forum whereas SDO, Sundargarh, SED appeared as respondent before the Forum.

Brief facts pertaining to the case are that the Complainant is a LT-Specified Public purpose consumer with connected load of 01 Kw. That the Complainant has raised objection regarding the wrong bill from the date of supply and provisional bills served to him. He requested for revision of bills and mentions about verbal complaint being made to the respondent earlier.

Gist of Arguments made by the Parties

Both parties were present in the hearing. The contentions made by the parties are as follows:

Submission of the Complainant:

- The complainant submitted that wrong bill during Jan'2024 and average bills for Feb'2024 to Mar'2024 served to him resulted to accumulation of arrear.
- He further submitted that he had made verbal complain to the respondent about the erroneous bill.
- He also requested the Forum to revise the bills.

Reply Submission of the Respondent:

- The respondent produced the billing abstract from Oct'2019 to Jun'2024.
- He had also produced a PVR dt.12.08.2024 mentioning the meter reading as "198" of meter number LW346079.
- The respondent also agreed to the wrong billing from Jan'2024 to Mar'2024. However, the respondent requested the Forum to take appropriate decision as necessary.

Findings of the Forum

Written/verbal Submissions were made by both parties and arguments were heard at length. This Forum, after hearing the parties and going through the relevant documents and provisions of law have concluded as follows:

- The bills for Feb'2020 have been billed on actual basis with meter reading "008" Kwh. During Jan'2024, provisional bill has been served for 6358 units and from Feb'2024 to Mar'2024, average bills have been served.
- As per PVR submitted by respondent, the same meter is continuing now.
- Therefore, it is decided by the Forum that, the provisional/wrong round billing period bills should be revised.

Directions of the forum

In view of the above findings and discussions, the Forum is of the view that,

- The wrong bills served to the complainant from Apr'2022 to Mar'2024 (Two Years) are to be revised by taking average from IMR "008" (Feb'2020) and FMR "179" (Apr'2024) as per Section 157 of Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code, 2019.
- Any adjustments done during the revision period are also to be taken into consideration.
- DPS charged on the wrong bills are also to be withdrawn.

Matter is closed herewith and the compliance report to be submitted to the undersigned on or before dated **30-09-2024**.


"If the complainant is aggrieved with this order or non-implementation of the order of the Grievance Redressal Forum in time, he/she can make the representation to the Ombudsman-II, Qrs. No. 3R-2(S), GRIDCO Colony, P.O: Bhoinagar, Bhubaneswar-751022 within 30 days from the date of order of the Grievances Redressal Forums".
