- Though the complainant had given NOC for other connection in the same building, she did not get the same from them.
- From the different documents and evidence submitted by her, it is proved that Vidotama Devi is the wife of Niraj Kumar Singh and Niraj Kumar Singh is the grandson of late Kedarnath Singh.
- One new connection had been released to one grandson of late Kedarnath Singh few months ago as the respondent informed.
- Though there is a suit in Court regarding land disputes going on, there is no injunction nor stay by the Court.
- As electricity is essential for habitation, the Forum is the opinion to give power to the complainant and in case of any adverse court order, the supply may be terminated.
- She must not be a defaulter of electricity charges even for a month after getting power supply. In case of failure to pay electricity charges, the respondent will disconnect power supply observing all departmental formalities.

## **Directions of the forum**

In view of the above findings and discussions, the Forum is of the view that,

- The Respondent must give power supply as early as possible.
- The Complainant must pay the electricity bill regularly without fail.
- In case of any adverse Court order, the power supply will be terminated by the Respondent.

Matter is closed herewith and the compliance report to be submitted to the undersigned on or before dated **31-12-2024**.
