ORDER

Brief Facts of the Case

During the spot hearing at Rajgangpur-II Electrical Sub-division camp on dt.20.12.2024, the complainant appeared before the Forum whereas SDO Electrical, Rajgangpur-I appeared as respondent before the Forum.

Brief facts pertaining to the case are that the Complainant is a LT-Domestic consumer having connected load of 0.5 KW. That the Complainant has raised objection for high billing during Dec-Jan'2019. He requested for revision of bills and mentions about verbal complaint being made to the respondent earlier on.

Gist of Arguments made by the Parties

Both parties were present in the hearing. The contentions made by the parties are as follows:

Submission of the Complainant:

- The complainant submitted that high bills have been generated during Dec-Jan'2019 due to which high billings have been done resulted to accumulation of arrears.
- He further submitted that he had made verbal complain to the respondent about the erroneous bill.
- He also requested the Forum to revise the bills.

Reply Submission of the Respondent:

- The respondent produced the following documents:
 - Billing abstract from Aug'2018 to Oct'2024.
 - Physical Verification Report on dt.17.12.2024.
 - Written version on dt.20.12.2024.
- The respondent also agreed to the wrong billing during Dec-Jan'2019 and revision of bills.
- However, the respondent requested the Forum to take appropriate decisions as necessary.

Findings of the Forum

Written/verbal Submissions were made by both parties and arguments were heard at length. This Forum, after hearing the parties and going through the relevant documents and provisions of law have concluded as follows:

- During Dec-Jan'2019, actual bill had been served with 6738 units which is wrong as the power supply had been taken on dt.16.08.2018.
- During Jul'2019, the reading again corrected as 224 Kwh.
- Meter bearing number 203835 continued up to Oct'2023.
- Therefore, it is decided by the Forum to recast the wrong bills.

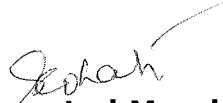
Directions of the forum

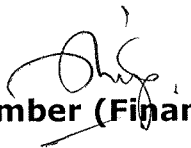
In view of the above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations 155 and 157 of the Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code, 2019.

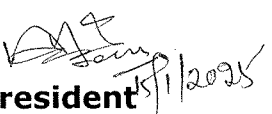
- The wrong bills served from Dec'2018 to Jul'2019 are to be revised by taking IMR "152" (CMR of Nov'2018) and FMR as "224" (CMR of Jul'2019).
- Any adjustments made during the revision period are also to be taken into consideration.
- DPS charged on the wrong bills are also to be withdrawn.

The matter is closed herewith.
